



Care Guide

A little care goes a long way. Every product from our collection is crafted with longevity in mind. We've gathered our knowledge and experience to share with you how to effortlessly prolong a lifespan of your accessories.

Our essential tips on how to protect noo.ma products. Please make sure you review them before first use.

- Avoid placing accessories in direct sunlight or near a strong heat source to reduce changes.
- Keep away from flammable objects, children and pets.
- Always remove stains quickly before they can cause any permanent damage to the product.
- Be careful not to scratch or damage the surface with sharp objects.

Wooden Tableware

- These products are not dish-washer safe. Hand wash with mild soap only.
- Do not place in water or by the strong heat source (radiator or refrigerator).
- Staining foods may leave temporary stains that get removed after several washings.
- In case of drying, application of oil is recommended in order to preserve the product. Use natural plant-oil like linen or coconut. Rub the oil on the bowl or platter, leave it for 30 min and wipe dry.
- The Oul Serving Set is not designed to be used with sharp objects (eg. as a cutting board).

Steel Accessories

- To clean the surface use a soft cloth with a mild detergent.
- Do not place in water or by the strong heat source (radiator or refrigerator).

Mirrors

- Fragile, handle with care.
- To clean the surface use a soft cloth with a mild detergent.
- In the event of breaking, sharp pieces of glass may be harmful.
- Avoid intense exposure to water.

Candle Holders

- The candle must be held in place by the nail in the center.
- To clean the surface use a soft cloth with a mild detergent.
- Make sure to blow out the candle before burning itself out to avoid staining.
- Always burn within sight.
- Wax can be removed with warm water.

Failure to follow instructions could result in fire hazard, injury, or smoke damage. Keep wick centered & trimmed to 1/4" to prevent smoking and soot building up on the object or other items.
